

Radiology Quality Management



Meeting the requirements of the New Zealand Code of Radiology Management Practice

This course is designed for radiology practice managers, medical radiation technologists (MRTs) and radiology quality management staff. It will assist them develop, implement and refine a documented management system and the subsequent practical requirements of accreditation by International Accreditation New Zealand (IANZ).

Key topics covered:

- Quality manual development and implementation.
- Document control
- Procurement of services and supplies Accommodation and environment
- Imaging procedures
- Staff recruitment, training, and continuing development
- Equipment management, calibration and quality control
- Patient management
- Service to, and feedback from patients and clinicians
- Corrective and preventive action
- Internal audits and management review recording and reporting.

This course is equally suited to radiology staff preparing for IANZ Accreditation, or to staff from IANZ Accredited services seeking to fine-tune existing systems and gain the best possible benefit from the accreditation process.
